3. If our offer of a grant has not been accepted within six months of the date of our grant offer letter it will automatically lapse.
4. The grant should be spent within six months of it being paid. If your competition has not started within six months of the date of offer letter we reserve the right to withdraw the application unless we have received a letter notifying us of the delay.
5. The grant should only be used for the purposes for which it is provided.
6. Our support should be mentioned in appropriate terms in publications, websites, events and other publicity relating to your project – copies should be supplied on request.
7. A grant evaluation and feedback form must be returned to the Head of Foundation on the use of your grant within six months of the end of the project or when the money has been spent. Please use the *Grant Evaluation Form* that was sent out with the grant offer letter.
