Job Description Cricket Lead Coach / Contract Player at Brixham Cricket Club

We require a committed and confident self-employed or directly employed lead coach to deliver our Senior squad and senior colts weekly training sessions, to assist colts integration into senior Saturday and Sunday League squads and to further develop our training programme.

Specific coaching requirements:

1. Plan and lead our weekly Tuesday evening coaching outdoor training sessions to be undertaken in the period commencing April 2021 (start date to be confirmed)
2. Oversee & conduct risk assessment at all sessions.
3. Knowledge and understanding of ECB Child Welfare procedures in relation to coaching responsibilities.
4. Conduct sessions in accordance with the appropriate ECB guidelines and good practice.
5. Encourage the players to act in a sportsmanlike manner at all times and ensure that the spirit of the game be promoted at all times.
6. Share good practise with all club coaches and volunteer helpers.
7. Work with the club committee to generate ideas, execute plans and collaborate so shared goals are achieved and to develop future player quality, forward planning and recruitment.

Person Specification –required coaching qualifications and experience:

1. Level 2 or above qualified coach. (Preferably pursuing level 3 qualification or with a proven track record for lead coach position).
2. Experience working with Seniors and children from 16+ years of age.
3. Up to date DBS, First Aid and Safeguarding Young Cricketers certification.
4. Committed every week to the schedule detailed above.
5. Excellent communication, organisational skills and punctuality.

Contract Player - Person Specification –required qualifications and experience:

1. Will have a proven track record in Devon Cricket League Division B or above or higher standard.
2. All round ability preferred but not essential.
3. Will be available to play in all Saturday Devon League and Sunday T20 Cup matches subject to Terms and Conditions below.
4. Act in a sportsmanlike manner at all times and ensure that the spirit of the game be promoted at all times.
5. Integrate with Senior squad and colts players to generate positive team attitude to achieve shared goals.
