## Travel to training sessions and matches policy

Devon Cricket (The Board's) policy is that parents or other responsible adults are responsible for transporting players to and from most matches and training sessions. On occasion the Board will arrange group transport to fixtures/festivals in a mini-bus or coach. The implementation of this policy is not intended to exclude any player from participation and parent's or guardians should contact the County Safeguarding Officer if they have any problems with the transportation of players to matches or training sessions.

Organisers, Coaches and/or Managers will be responsible for children in their care when they have arrived at the indoor venue, cricket club or on arrival at opponents' cricket grounds.

It is not the responsibility of the coaches or team Manager to transport or arrange to transport children to and from the indoor venue, cricket club or opponents' cricket grounds.
